The lander Vikram successfully soft landed in the lunar south-pole region, achieving humanity's first soft landing in the region and making India the fourth country to soft land on the Moon after Soviet Union, United States and China. Soon after the touchdown, the rover Pragyan got down of the ramp and drove 8 m. (26 ft) making India only the third country to operate a robotic rover on the Moon after Soviet Union and China. The whole launch was visualised in the screen in the college auditorium and the teachers, students along with the non-teaching staff were present to celebrate the success.



The Director of Higher Education Assam visited the college to inspect and see the progress of admission into FYUGP 1st Semester through Samarth E-gov. Portal.






SHE STANDS OUT


DEPARTMENTAL SEMINAR (31.05.2024)






TRAINING PROGRAMME ON "POWER POINT PRESENTATION SKILL" (03/06/2024)



WORKSHOP ON SPSS AND ITS APPLICATION (12.06.2024)




