


NAAC PEER TEAM VISIT

The year 2023 brought one of the very proud moments for Suren Das College, when the college successfully completed the 3rd cycle of NAAC assessment, and is now recognized as an 'A' grade college. The NAAC PEER TEAM had visited the college premises on 9th and 10th February, 2023.

The team consisted of Prof. (Dr.) A.D.N. Bajpai (Chairperson), Prof. (Dr.) Aravind Mulimani (Member Coordinator) and Dr. Madhu Prashar (Member). On day zero, that is on February 8, 2023, the pre visit meeting of the Peer Team with the Principal of the College and the IQAC Coordinator, was held at the place of their stay and the schedule for the next two days was finalized.







On 9th February, the Peer Team arrived at 9 AM and was offered a grand welcome by the students and staff of the College. The first day of the assessment included programmes like presentations by the Principal, IQAC Coordinator and Heads of the Departments, visit to the Departments and laboratories, interaction with teaching and nonteaching staff, alumni, students and guardians, visit to physical facilities like library, gymnasium, computer center, canteen etc. and verification of office records and accounts. The proceedings of Day 1 ended with a colourful cultural program representing the traditional and cultural diversity of the region, performed by the students of the college, which was highly appreciated by the Peer Team members.



On 10th February, the Peer Team interacted with the coordinators of the cells and verified the records and documents. The team members mostly remained busy with the writing and uploading of the final report. In the evening, Exit meeting was held and the report of the assessment was handed over to the college authority, marking the end of the two day hectic schedule of the NAAC Peer Team visit.

The NSS unit organised plantation, poster making and slogan writing competitions on the occasion of World Environment Day.



Induction Programme by Dept. of Economics:




Awareness program on Tobacco prohibition:






MoU
